The 20th Anniversary Motul Petit Le Mans is not only the IMSA WeatherTech Champ-ionship season finale, but also the title decider for the Toyota/Patriot North American Endurance Cup (TPNAC). This championship takes place within the season-long IMSA schedule and settles the points from the four endurance rounds - Daytona, Sebring, Watkins Glen and Road Atlanta - to select a winner.

WEATHERTECH CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES OF COMPETITION



PROTOTYPE (P) The class features the latest and most technologically advanced cars in North America. They are specifically designed and engineered for the race track and look drastically different than original street cars.



PROTOTYPE CHALLENGE (PC) The class is a open class featuring open-cockpit race cars and technology such as a carbon fiber chassis, carbon brakes and suspension systems. (IMS, IMSA, FIA/GP)



GT1 (GT1) The most affordable and fastest GT car on the track. They are based on production models and are engineered to meet the maximum performance possible. The class serves as a true proving ground for leading manufacturers such as BMW, Corvette, Ferrari, Ford, and Porsche.



GT SPORTING (GTSP) The GT Sporting are an enhanced class defined by technology. They are also based on production models but do not feature the same level of aerodynamics and power as the GT1 class cars. The GTSP class consists of GT open cars.
