WHAT BUSINESSES & COVID-19



WORK FROM HOME

Allow employees to work from home as much as possible.



WEAR MASKS

Employees should wear masks. It's ideal if you can provide the masks.



WASH YOUR HANDS

Use warm water and soap for at least **20** seconds.




COVER YOUR COUGH

Use a tissue to cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze. Throw used tissues in a lined trash can.



CLEAN & DISINFECT

Use Lysol, Clorox or other disinfecting products to clean phones, keyboards, tablets, counters, tables, doorknobs, toilets and other shared items in common areas.



MAKE DISTANCING EASY

Adjust work areas to allow for **6 feet** of separation as much as possible.



TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS FOR EMPLOYEES

Employees with a temperature of **100°F** or greater should not enter the workplace. Provide next steps about whether they should seek care through your employee health processes, or if they should call their doctor.



RELY ON HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS TO ORDER TESTING

If you think an employee may need to be tested, please call the Northeast Georgia Physicians Group COVID Hotline, Longstreet Clinic or the Hall County Health Department. They can advise next steps for treatment and coordinate testing if needed.
