

Job Tax Credits*

Qualified businesses in Gainesville-Hall County may qualify for this credit if they create at least 25 new jobs in a calendar year. Job Tax Credits of \$1,250 each year for five years for each new full-time job created apply to companies that are engaged in the following:

- Manufacturing/Processing
- Research & Development
- Distribution
- Headquarters
- Tourism

Example: \$1,250 x 25 new jobs x 5 years = \$156,250 in tax credits (Form IT-CA 2012).

Port Job Tax Credit Bonus is a \$1,250 per job bonus for businesses that have a 10% increase in Georgia port traffic over the previous year.

Opportunity Zones

Opportunity Zones within Midtown Gainesville and the Atlanta Highway area allow for job tax credits of \$3,500 for each of five years per net new job created and maintained. The credits can be applied against the Georgia Corporate Income Tax or Georgia Withholding Tax. Businesses must create two (2) or more new jobs.

1. *Job, Investment, and Retraining Tax Credits may be used to offset up to 50% of a company's Georgia corporate income tax liability in any taxable year following the year in which the credits are earned. Credits not used may be carried forward and applied for up to 10 years.*
2. *Created jobs must be full-time with benefits and not replacement positions. The new positions must pay a minimum of \$12.77 per hour.*
3. *Taxpayers may choose between Job Tax Credits, Quality Job Tax Credits or Investment Tax Credits in a given year. Consult regulations for the definition of a qualified business.*
4. *Quality Job Tax Credits may be used to offset payroll withholding once all of the tax liability has been exhausted and may be carried forward for 10 years.*

Note: The Downtown/Midtown Opportunity Zone expires on December 31, 2020. The West Gainesville/Atlanta Highway Opportunity Zone expires December 31, 2025.

Expansion Rules of Thumb

If any of the following apply to your company, please check applicable incentives:

- *Addition of 5+ new jobs in a given year*
- *Capital Investment of \$50,000+ in a given year*
- *Training Investment of \$40,000+ in a three-year period for existing employees*

Inventory Tax Exemption (Freeport)

100% of Freeport Tax Exemption (ad valorem) is available on raw materials, goods in process, and finished goods destined for out-of-state shipment with applications due April 1.

**Applications must be submitted annually (Form PT-50PF).*

Financing

Gainesville-Hall County maintains a stable tax environment and offers attractive incentives to new and existing businesses to encourage investment and the creation of new jobs. Various finance options are available for qualified businesses on fixed assets and working capital. Contact us for additional details.

Retraining Tax Credits*

Direct investment for employee retraining for quality and productivity enhancements and certain software technologies as approved by Lanier Technical College may qualify for credits of 50% of the employer's direct cost of up to \$500 per employee.

Multi-Shift Accelerated Depreciation

Production machinery and equipment utilized over 85% of total available time (7,446 hours per year) in multi-shift operations for the 12 months preceding the January 1 assessment date may qualify for an accelerated depreciation allowance.

**Applications must be submitted annually (Form MS1).*

Quick Start Training

Customized training may be delivered at no cost to qualifying businesses with an expanding job base. The service typically includes training analysis, development of training materials, and training to reach maximum productivity in a minimum amount of time. Quick Start training is nationally recognized as the #1 customized training program for business and industry.

Sales and Use Tax and Exemptions

Gainesville-Hall County and the State of Georgia Sales Tax totals 7%. Georgia Law provides a Sales and Use Tax Exemptions for qualified purchases including:

- Manufacturing & Equipment Purchases & Repair
- Raw Materials & Packaging
- Energy Used in Manufacturing
- Primary Material Handling Equipment
- Pollution Control Equipment

Quality Job Tax Credits

Businesses qualify for this tax credit if they create a minimum of 50 new jobs that pay at least 110% of the county average (estimated \$22.28 per hour). Credits are per job, per year, for up to five years based on an increasing scale system.

Example: $\$2,500 \times 50 \text{ qualified jobs} \times 5 \text{ years} = \$625,000$ in tax credits (Form IT-QJ & Form IT-WH).

Advanced Manufacturing Technology

The Advanced Manufacturing Technology Center at Lanier Technical College provides access to four labs with the latest robotic, PLC equipment and systems. Companies maximize productivity with hands-on training in operation, programming, welding, maintenance and troubleshooting. Customized training is available.

Corporate Income Tax Reduction

"Single Factor Gross Receipts" apportionment formula results in a substantial and permanent reduction of Georgia income taxes for companies that manufacture products within the state of Georgia and sell those products or services to customers in other states. Georgia's Corporate Income Tax rate of 5.75% is applied only to income apportioned to Georgia by sales.

Less Developed Census Tracts*

Qualified businesses located within census tracts designated as "Less Developed" that create at least five new jobs in a calendar year may qualify for increased Job Tax Credit incentives of \$3,500 each year for five years for each new full-time job. Credits may be applied against state corporate income or withholding tax.

Example: $\$3,500 \times 5 \text{ new jobs} \times 5 \text{ years} = \$87,500$ in tax credits (Form IT-CA2012 & Form IT-WH).

Gainesville Career Center
